

FREE CLINIC TO SEAL YOUR JUVENILE RECORDS

Do you want to have your juvenile records sealed? When you seal your juvenile records relating to an arrest or court case, the court deems the arrest or court case "never to have occurred." This means that when you apply to most jobs or colleges, you may be able to say you were never arrested and that you have no criminal history. It can be helpful to seal your juvenile arrest record even if you were never put on probation.

Is this you?

- You were arrested before you turned 18,
- You are now 18 to 24 years old,
- You are off probation or parole, and
- You have not been convicted of a felony AFTER you turned 18.

If this is you, you MIGHT be able to seal your juvenile records. To schedule a free appointment at our clinic, even if you aren't sure about the rules, please call 707-622-6685. APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED.
